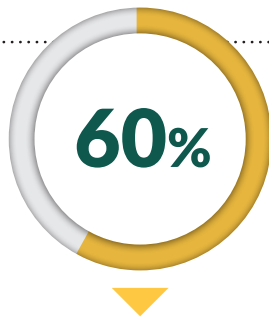

### THE IMPACT

- **1,000 students** participated in 70 student organizations

- **200 students** traveled to national conferences
- **3 World Health Student Organization** medical relief trips to Ecuador and the Dominican Republic
- **14 student-authored resolutions** adopted into policy by the American Medical Association
- **430 young Detroiters** mentored in health, fitness and nutrition programs
- **750 first aid kits** and 24 naloxone kits distributed in Detroit



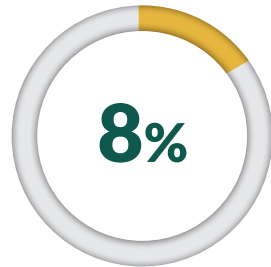

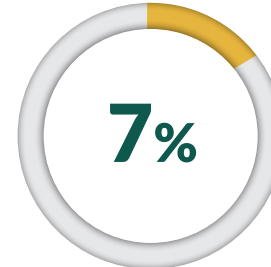

**THE IMPACT**

- **98% first-attempt pass rate** on USMLE Step 1
- **98.16% match rate**, nearly **4% higher** than the national average
- **50% matched** into Michigan residency programs

- **4,715 participated** in alumni-sponsored programs and volunteer initiatives
- **833 students** attended Medical Specialty Lunches and Learning Community Dinners
- **641 alumni**, students and kids ages 6 to 12 visited the School of Medicine for the FutureDocs experience
