WHAT IS P4?

Population, Patient, Physician and Professionalism (P4) is a longitudinal 1st & 2nd year medical student course in social and behavioral health and health system science designed to guide students to: provide patient-centered and culturally responsive care, to become effective team members, to learn evidence based theories that reduce healthcare disparities, and to recognize their own professional development.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- Identify health disparities for underserved and historically marginalized populations.
- Examine the patient, community, physician, health system and policy level factors contributing to these disparities.
- Reflect on internal beliefs, biases and values as they inform professional identity formation.
