I am offering my nomination for John Purakal, MD (Class of 2014) for the Wayne State University School of Medicine Recent Alumni Award. His clinical acumen, leadership, teaching skills and interests in Social Emergency Medicine (SEM) have been exemplified during his time at the University of Chicago.

Dr. Purakal graduated from WSU SOM in May 2014, and completed residency and served as chief resident at University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) in Emergency Medicine. During his time at UIC, he created a train the trainer course in ACLS that was implemented in Nairobi (Kenya), which has since become a healthcare training organization (medswipe.co.ke) that is training young physicians in ACLS throughout the country. For these efforts, he was awarded the "Humanitarian Award" at his residency graduation. He then joined the faculty at University of Chicago Department of Emergency Medicine.

Dr. Purakal's commitment to community service, reduction of health disparities and social emergency medicine truly sets him apart. His SEM project, Raising Our Community's Knowledge (ROCK), is a public health initiative aimed at bridging gaps in knowledge amongst our patients and the community. He created a similar initiative while a medical student at Wayne State University SOM. Once he arrived to U of C, he immediately got to work by meeting with clinicians and organizations on campus, who are committed to community outreach, in an effort to build bridges with like-minded initiatives. At the same time, he has reached out to residents at UChicago Medicine and students of University of Chicago Pritzker School of Medicine, giving them opportunities to not only serve, but become ambassadors to the community. Their target audiences are churches, community centers, nursing homes and public schools. (www.uchicagorock.com)

These students, residents, and faculty members he has enlisted have given lectures in the community and become a coalition of educators to address gaps in knowledge that are commonplace amongst our patients. His work is focused primarily on patient education, with the goal of improved health beliefs, leading to improved health choices for a traditionally underserved population. ROCK has also targeted a particularly high-risk group: patients in the ED. By giving short lectures to patients in the ED and inviting patients and their family members to the free talks hosted on campus, this initiative is providing a novel way to address health disparities amongst a diverse array of communities who present to our department. His perseverance has led to the formation of a formal student organization at Pritzker School of Medicine, and is in the process of becoming a formalized undergraduate student organization at the University of Chicago, which will give his efforts sustainable social impact in southside Chicago. In addition, Dr. Purakal works with the Urban Health Initiative at U of C to advance the patient advocate system, a group of professionals employed in the ED to address issues related to access to care and social determinants of health.
